

Relief Kitchen Support Worker – Big Hill Lodge

What is a relief kitchen support worker?

- Relief kitchen support workers provide coverage for our full-time employees when they are away, or if there are temporary needs to be filled.

What would I be doing?

- As a **Kitchen Aide** duties would include supporting the kitchen by doing dishes and handling general cleaning of the kitchen and dining room, as well as customer service.
- As a **Dishwasher** duties would include supporting the kitchen by doing dishes, cleaning, and customer service.

When would I work?

- Kitchen Aide shift times are 3 PM - 11 PM or 11PM - 7 AM weekdays, and 7 PM - 7 AM or 7 AM - 7 PM weekends and statutory holidays.
- Dishwashing shift times are 7 AM - 3 PM weekdays.
- We are staffed 24/7 and shifts may include statutory holidays and weekends.
- Relief workers are called in to work where needed, as needed, on an on-call basis.

Is this me?

- Are you able to work shift work including overnights, a team player, reliable and committed to seniors?
- Do you have strong critical thinking and emergency management skills?
- Please note, part of the employment offer includes the completion of a criminal record check.

Why should I work with Rocky View Foundation?

- We offer a comprehensive orientation and on the job training program to prepare you for your first shift on your own.
- Our start rate is \$17.68 per hour, shift premiums, and a meal benefit.
- Health and Safety is critical for our staff and residents, and we hold our Certificate of Recognition (COR).
- All employees are COVID screened prior to beginning work and throughout their shift.
